INTESA SANPAOLO SPONSORS THE "LAST SUPPER IN POMPEII" EXHIBITION IN OXFORD, AN EXPLORATION OF THE CUSTOMS OF THE CITIZENS OF POMPEII JUST HOURS BEFORE THE ERUPTION OF VESUVIUS

Ashmolean Museum of Art and Archaeology – Oxford (UK)
From Thursday 25 July 2019 to Sunday 12 January 2020
Items on display from the Archaeological Park of Pompeii and Paestum, and the National Archaeological Museum of Naples

Oxford (UK), 24 July 2019 – Tomorrow will see the opening of the "Last Supper in Pompeii" exhibition at the Ashmolean Museum of Art and Archaeology of Oxford, an initiative sponsored by Intesa Sanpaolo. The sponsorship forms part of a wider collaborative agreement between the banking Group and the prestigious Oxford University, which includes training initiatives, scientific research, exchange projects and scholarships. Given a snapshot image of the eruption of Vesuvius in 79 AD, visitors will discover daily Roman life – from the farmed fields to the taverns, the marketplace, the triclinium (dining room), the kitchens and the places of worship.

Over 300 archaeological artefacts are on display (some only recently discovered), including objects used in daily life such as tools, vases, the carbonised remains of food preserved by volcanic ash, mosaics, and treasures from the Archaeological Park of Pompeii and Paestum, the National Archaeological Museum of Naples, the British Museum, the Museum of London Archaeology, and private collections.

The exhibition was curated by Paul Roberts, Sackler Keeper of Antiquities at the Museum and curator of the record-breaking exhibition *Life and Death in Pompeii and Herculaneum*, which was held in 2013 at the British Museum. Re-evoking the extraordinary atmosphere of a traditional Roman banquet, the exhibition lets visitors embark on a journey through Roman dining and gastronomy, highlighting the Roman people's love of food and good wine.
